



Scholarship Application Notice

New England Chapter APWA Career Advancement Opportunity

The New England Chapter of the American Public Works Association is pleased to announce the availability of five \$1,000 reimbursable scholarships, one awarded per state, 2024 to promote and improve financial assistance to individuals committed to the Public Works Profession who are seeking opportunities to advance within their department.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicants must be working for a municipality.
- 2. Applicants must be members or have a sponsor that is a current member of the New England Chapter of the American Public Works Association. (Applicants do not have to be APWA members at the time of their application.)
- 3. The applicant's advancement opportunity must be in a technical or a management program that relates to the Public Works profession.
- 4. Award winner shall become a member of New England APWA for a minimum of one (1) year within six (6) months of notice of the award and prior to receiving any funds.

FUNDING

1. The scholarships winners will be notified in May. Funds will be payable at completion of the program as a reimbursement. Winners will be reimbursed up to \$1,000 per State. A summary of what the course provided you and if you would recommend it to a colleague shall be submitted with reimbursement request. Proof of membership shall also be provided for reimbursement.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Chapter's Scholarship Committee will screen all applications and rank applicants who are eligible. Interviews may be conducted by members of the Scholarship Committee and Chapter Director(s) from the State(s) of residency of the applicants. *Up to \$1,000 per state per year*.
